

Phrasal/ prepositional verbs

Em inglês, muitos verbos são constituídos por duas partes:

- Verbo base (like, sit, stare, wait...)
- Preposição ou adverbio (in, out, on, off...)

A união destes dois constituintes pode:

- combinar os dois significados (come in, walk across)
- a primeira palavra mantém o significado, alterando a segunda (break up, tire out)
- altera o significado das duas partes (give up, blow up)

Alguns exemplos:

catch up	go in	put out
check in	go off	run out
check out	go on	signed up
come around	hold on	sitting in
come down	hurry up	speed up
come in	listened to	staring at
come out	lobby for	started out
come up with	look after	talked with
cut down	look around	take off
die out	look for	try on
drink up	look forward	turning out
get around	pick out	waiting for
get away	put off	wake up
